

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF GOODING, STATE OF IDAHO, PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO REQUEST OR DEMAND ELECTRIC POWER CONNECTION WITHOUT FIRST DISPLAYING A VALID BUILDING PERMIT ISSUED BY GOODING COUNTY; PROVIDING THAT A VIOLATION SHALL CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Gooding County Board of Commissioners, GOODING COUNTY, IDAHO, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any individual, corporation, or other entity to request or demand from any utility, public or private, the connection of power to any structure, house, building, installation, including mobile homes, for which a building permit is required by Gooding County, without first displaying to said utility or other company a valid building permit issued by Gooding County.

Section 2. It shall be a misdemeanor for any such individual, corporation or entity to violate this Ordinance, and it shall be a misdemeanor to mislead the utility or other company by showing a permit which is not duly, regularly issued, or which does not cover the structure or installation for which power is sought, or to represent falsely that no such permit is required by the Ordinances of Gooding County.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
