

ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GOODING COUNTY, IDAHO, EXTENDING THE HOURS OF SALE AND PERMITTING SUNDAY, MEMORIAL DAY, AND THANKSGIVING DAY SALE OF LIQUOR BY THE DRINK.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Gooding County, Idaho:

SECTION 1 - AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE

(1) This ordinance is adopted pursuant to authority granted by Idaho Code Section 23-927(2).

(2) The purpose of this ordinance is to extend the hours of sale of liquor by the drink and to permit the sale of liquor by the drink on Sunday, Memorial Day and Thanksgiving Day by all licensed establishments within Gooding County.

SECTION 2 - HOURS OF SALE OF LIQUOR BY THE DRINK

(1) The sale of liquor by the drink by those establishments within Gooding County licensed by law to do so is hereby set upon Friday and Saturday from the hour of ten o'clock (10:00) a.m. to the hour of two o'clock (2:00) a.m. the following day.

(2) The sale of liquor by the drink by those establishments within Gooding County licensed by law to do so on Sunday, Memorial Day and Thanksgiving Day is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective upon proper publication thereof.

SECTION 4 - REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All other ordinances, parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed upon the effective date of this ordinance.

THE FOREGOING ORDINANCE IS APPROVED AND ADOPTED AS AN OFFICIAL ACT OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GOODING COUNTY, IDAHO, TO BE EFFECTIVE UPON PROPER PUBLICATION.
