

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF GOODING, STATE OF IDAHO, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 22 AND ITS PROVISIONS THAT PROVIDE THAT CITY LAND USE PLANS AND CITY SUBDIVISION AND ZONING ORDINANCES SHALL BE THE APPLICABLE REGULATIONS IN AREAS OF CITY IMPACT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GOODING COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That Gooding County Ordinance Number 22 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: That the land use plan and all amendments thereto adopted by the County of Gooding and the zoning and subdivision Ordinances and subsequent amendments thereto, together with all building codes and regulations, building inspections and fees as officially adopted by Gooding County shall apply in the areas of City impact for the cities of Bliss, Gooding, Wendell and Hagerman as those areas are defined in Section I, II, III, and IV of Gooding County Ordinance Number 20, including any amendments thereto.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be effective upon proper publication thereof.

After due consideration, it was moved by Commissioner Robert E. Tupper and seconded by Commissioner Don C. Morrow that the foregoing Ordinance be approved and adopted as an official act of the Board, to be effective upon proper publication. Chairman Muffley put the motion to a vote, with three (3) members voting in the affirmative.
