

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3 BY AMENDING SECTION 3 TO PROVIDE THAT AFTER EXAMINATION OF THE APPLICATION AND AFTER DETERMINING THAT ALL REQUESTED INFORMATION IS CONTAINED ON THE APPLICATION THE PERMIT MAY BE GRANTED AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GOODING COUNTY, IDAHO.

SECTION 1

That section 3 of ordinance No. 3 be amended to provide as follows:

All applications for a building permit under this ordinance shall be examined by the permit administrator who shall, during the course of his examination, confer with other public officials that he deems may be interested in the proposed building or building site. After examination of the application and after determining that the requested information is contained on the application the permit may be granted provided, however, if the application will violate any county ordinance or state law it shall be denied. Such decision of the permit administrator may be appealed within 30 days to the Gooding County Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 2

Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective upon proper publication thereof.

After due consideration, it was moved by Commissioner Nelson R. King, and seconded by Commissioner John R. LeMoyné that the foregoing ordinance be approved and adopted as an official act of this Board to be effective upon proper publication. Chairman Glauner put the motion to a vote with all members voting in the affirmative.
