

ORDINANCE 7

AN ORDINANCE OF GOODING COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 5, ORDINANCE 6 BY PROVIDING THAT THE ORDINANCE BE EFFECTIVE FOR A PERIOD OF 240 DAYS AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY:

WHEREAS, the Gooding County Board of Commissioners have passed Ordinance No. 6 and desire to extend the period of time during which the Ordinance will be effective;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Gooding County, Idaho:

SECTION 1 - SECTION 5 ORDINANCE NO. 6 BE AMENDED

The Board of County Commissioners of Gooding County Find that an impending danger requires the immediate operation of this Ordinance; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in effect upon the proclamation of the Board of County Commissioners posted in at least five places in the County. This Ordinance shall be effective for 240 days.

SECTION 2 - DANGERS STILL PENDING

The Board of County Commissioners of Gooding County find that the dangers existing at the time of the enactment of the original Ordinance are still pending; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in effect upon the proclamation of the Board of County Commissioners posted in at least five places in the County.

After due consideration it was moved by Commissioner LeMoyne and seconded by Commissioner King, that the foregoing Ordinance be approved and adopted as an official act of this Board to be effective upon posting as stated in Section 2 hereof. Chairman Glauner put the motion to a vote with all members voting in the affirmative.
