**INDIGENT**

Commissioner Buhler moved to go into an executive session pursuant to IC§31-874 to consider indigent matters. Commissioner Bolton seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Bolton-Yes, Buhler– Yes, Bolduc-Yes. Director, Kathy Ball and Case Worker Kaitlin Leguineche joined the meeting. The board recessed executive session and returned to regular session at 10:08 a.m.

**PERSONNEL MANUAL**

Prosecutor Misseldine explained that ICRMP's, Tammy Middleton, had explained that our policy allows the department head to ask for a doctor's note when an employee is out three unplanned days or more. The employees doctor note may reveal a treatment for something that needs a reasonable accommodation. The prosecutor feels that a doctors not may reveal private HIPAA information and the practice should be eliminated.

We need to make considerations on the bereavement leave and the personal day off. Prosecutor Misseldine suggested adding a day and half per year to the PTO accrual, in place of the bereavement and preferred day benefit. The Board did not express any objection to the changes suggested by Prosecutor Misseldine.
